NOTIFICATION

(On constitution of State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority
and State Level Expert Appraisal Committee)

In exercising the powers conferred by Sub-section (3) of Section 3 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) and in pursuance of the Government of India notification number S.O. 1533(E) dated September 14, 2006, the Central Government, during the year 2007, has constituted the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) for the states of West Bengal, Karnataka, Gujarat, Andhra Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh, Meghalaya, Himachal Pradesh and Daman, Diu, Dadra and Nagar Haveli (hereinafter referred to as the Authority, respective state), comprising three members, namely, Chairman, Member and Member Secretary, nominated by the respective State Government.

The Chairman and the members shall have the term of three years from the date of publication of this notification in the Official Gazette.

The Authority of respective states / UT shall exercise such powers and follow such procedures as enumerated in the notification number S.O. 1533(E) dated September 14, 2006.

The Authority shall base its decision on the recommendations of the State Level Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC) constituted for the respective states / UT in this order.

The Secretariat for the Authority and State Governments shall provide all financial and logistic support including accommodation, transportation and such other facilities in respect of all its statutory functions. Sitting fee, Travelling Allowance / Dearness Allowance to the Chairman and Member of the Authority shall be paid by State Governments as per State rules.

To assist the said Authority, the Central Government, in consultation with the respective State Governments, has constituted the State Level Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC).

The Chairman and Members shall have the term of three years from the date of publication of this notification in the Official Gazette and SEAC shall be reconstituted after every three years of respective state/UTs.

The SEAC of respective state/UTs shall exercise such powers and follow such procedures as enumerated in the notification number S.O. 1533(E) dated September 14, 2006.

The SEAC of respective state/UTs shall function on the principle of collective responsibility. The Chairperson shall endeavour to reach a consensus in each case, and if consensus cannot be reached, the view of the majority shall prevail.

The secretariat for the SEAC of respective state/UTs and State Government shall provide all financial and logistic support including accommodation, transportation and such other facilities in respect to all its statutory functions. Sitting fee, Travelling Allowance / Dearness Allowance, to the Chairman and Members of the SEAC shall be paid by the State Government of respective states per State rules.
